Rays of Light Provides free respite care to parents with kids with special needs and their siblings. We assign our volunteers children to play with for four hours on the campus of Lovers Lane UMC, while their parents receive four free hours. In June, we have Summer Splash, 6/3 and 6/10, from 12:30pm to 5pm. where we include outside water activities in addition to our regular inside activities and we do have events in August on Fridays, 8/4, 8/11 and 8/18, from 5:30 pm to 10pm. All volunteers are required to provide volunteer applications which they can find on our website, www.raysoflightdallas.org, under "Get Involved" and a letter of recommendation.
